



Lowering Link Installation Instructions
Suzuki DRZ400
05-04201-29/05-04202-29 MX Lowering Link

1. Place the bike on a box stand.
2. Remove the two 17mm nuts that hold the links to the rocker and the swing arm and push the bolts out the left side.
3. Push the four bushing out of the stock links with a 16-18mm punch, and reinstall them in the PSR link with the washer part on the inside.
4. Be sure the thick stock washer on both sides of the rocker and swing arm mounts are over the bearing sleeve, and are pressing against the seal before the link mounting bolts are tightened.
5. Torque both the link mounting bolt nuts to 72.5 lb-ft.

For the best performance set the sag at 2.75" for 05-04202-29 link, or 3.25" for 05-04201-29.

If the links are for lowering purposes only, set the sag at 3.75"

Professional installation is recommended. Always use proper safety measures during the install of this product. Do not try to install this product without proper tools, recently calibrated torque wrench, correct torque specifications from factory service manual, safety goggles and gloves.
